

All this week Bolinas artists, former Bolinas Museum directors and other volunteers have helped install the Bean Finneran exhibition at the Museum. Now the new exhibitions are ready for you to enjoy!

MAIN GALLERY **BEAN FINNERAN: SPECTRA**

Curated by Jennifer Gately Through March 16

Ceramic artist Bean Finneran is internationally known for vibrant sculptures and installations composed of thousands of simple elemental forms inspired by the marshlands surrounding her Greenbrae studio. While Finneran's stacks, rings, and cones made from handrolled clay curves spring from the repetition of shape and form found in nature, they are always surprisingly new. In addition to her signature curve sculptures, this exhibition features the public debut of a unique, large wall installation composed of common masonry bricks, each hand glazed in electric hues.

Bean Finneran's sculpture has been included in exhibitions worldwide and can be found in the collections of the John Michael Kohler Arts Center, San Jose Museum of Art, and Mills College among others

Don't miss the fascinating artists talks! Starting at 2 PM the artists featured in each gallery will talk about their work and answer questions. Free.




Book Review by Hawk Weston
