All this week Bolinas artists, former Bolinas Museum directors and other volunteers have helped install the Bean Finneran exhibition at the Museum. Now the new exhibitions are ready for you to enjoy!

**BEAN FINNERAN: SPECTRA**

Ceramic artist Bean Finneran is internationally known for vibrant sculptures and installations composed of thousands of simple elemental forms inspired by the marshlands surrounding her Greenbrae studio. While Finneran's stacks, rings, and cones made from hand-rolled clay curves spring from the repetition of shape and form found in nature, they are always surprisingly new. In addition to her signature curve sculptures, this exhibition features the public debut of a unique, large wall installation composed of common masonry bricks, each hand glazed in electric hues.

Bean Finneran's sculpture has been included in exhibitions worldwide and can be found in the collections of the John Michael Kohler Arts Center, San Jose Museum of Art, and Mills College among others.

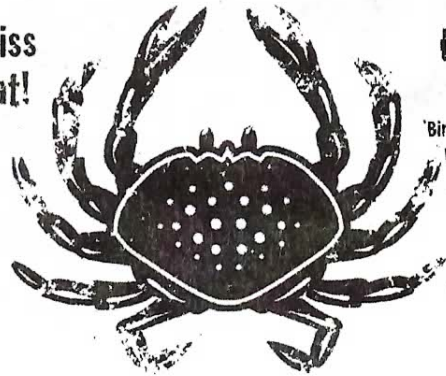
READING TO JOHN

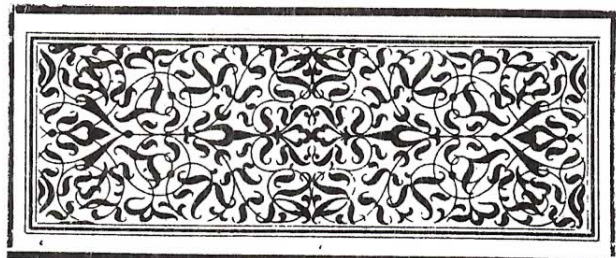

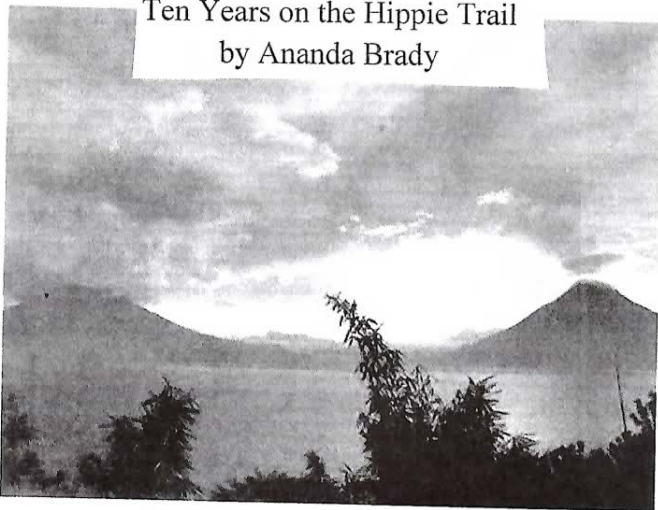

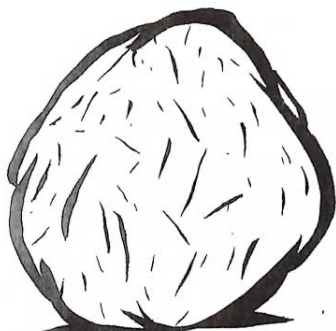
Book Review by Hawk Weston

I promise you this book is funny, deep, and will be one of the best books you will ever read. Go for it!

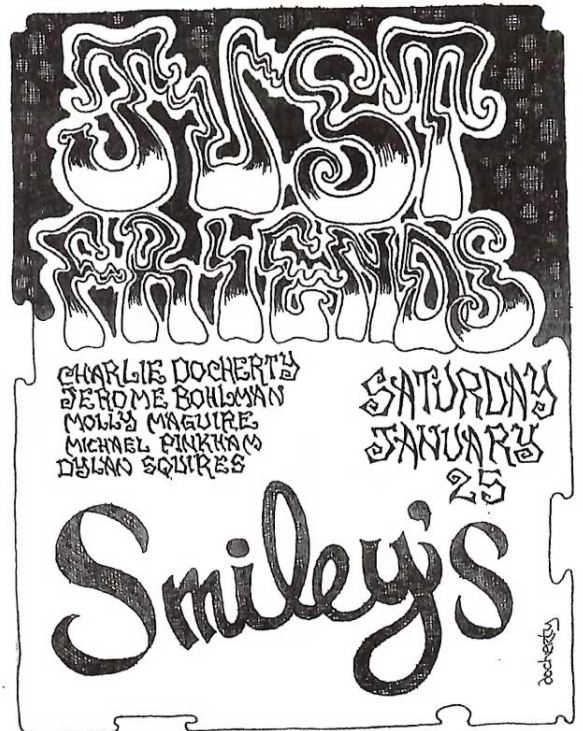

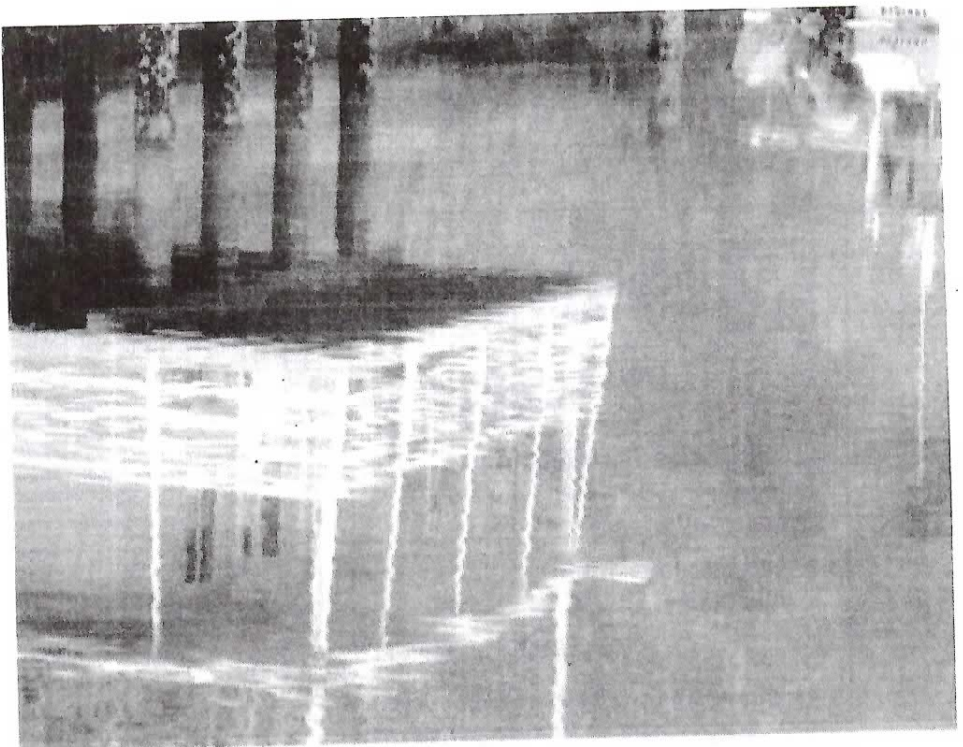
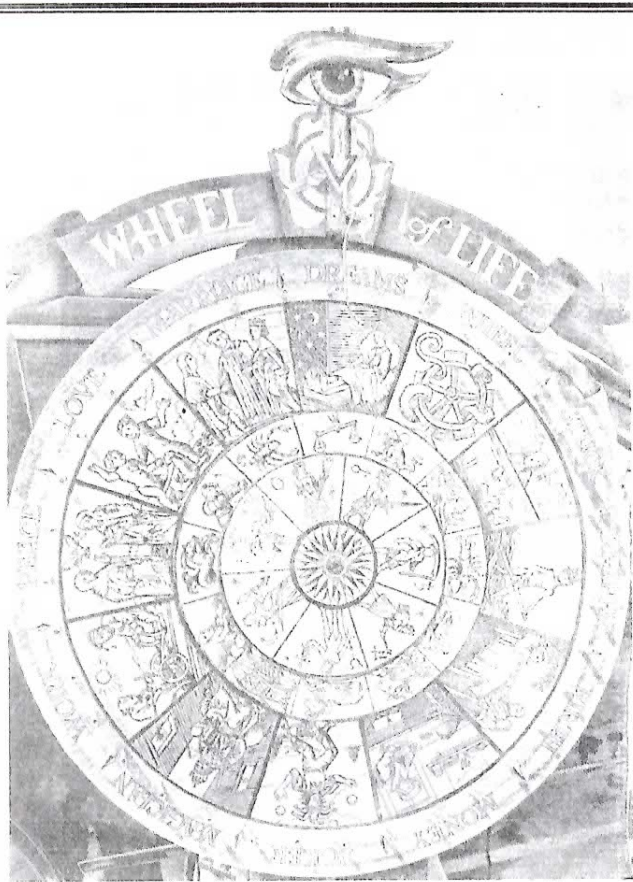

But I fixed the damage. Now the Wheel of Life is as good as new. New fortunes too - well maybe a few left over from Burning Man.

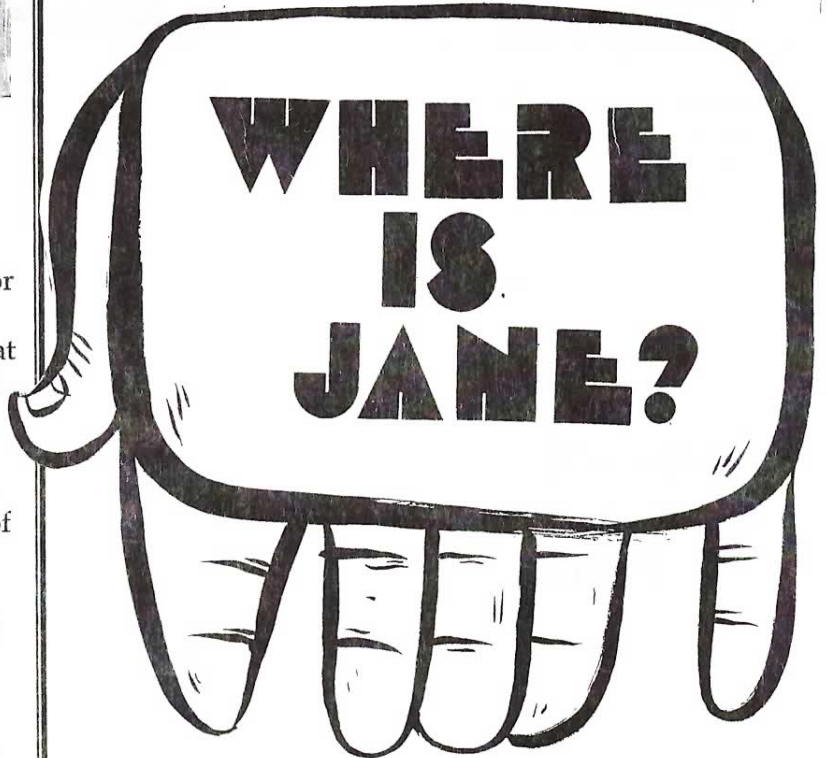
Besides spinning your fortune, check out my tie art. I stapled a bunch of neckties onto a canvas and voila! - tie art!
