



WATER SUPPLY UPDATE January 31, 2014




To the Bolinas Community:

THANK YOU!!! This community's response to the BCPUD's January 17th implementation of a heightened voluntary conservation alert has been nothing short of exceptional. We asked for a 25% reduction in consumption district-wide, and you have exceeded this goal. As of the end of the week, district water consumption has declined approximately 32% (as compared to average consumption levels during 2013). Very importantly, as a result of your efforts to conserve, we have been able to meet your demand for water by using our preferred water source, the Arroyo Hondo Creek, and we have not needed to divert any of our emergency stored water from our reservoirs. This is fantastic and enables us to defer mandatory rationing at this time. Please keep up your efforts and continue to do whatever you can to conserve water.



FIRE DEPARTMENT ALERT

I am sure everyone is aware that we are in the midst of a record setting winter in regards to a lack of rain. 2013 will go down as the driest year on record. With the drought comes the increased and significant threat of wildfire. Currently, a complete burn ban has been declared indefinitely for all State Response Area's (SRA). All of Bolinas is in the SRA therefore absolutely no open burning is allowed. This means no fires outside. All burn permits previously allowed by the fire department are suspended.

All of us must be vigilant when it comes to fire safety. If you use your fireplace, be sure your chimney is screened properly. If you see any kind of outside fire, call 911. With the vegetation still so dry, a small fire can quickly grow into a larger, devastating one. Keep your address sign visible, your roadway clear enough for engines to get in and out and your defensible space in place. Your fire prevention efforts can help protect lives and property.




