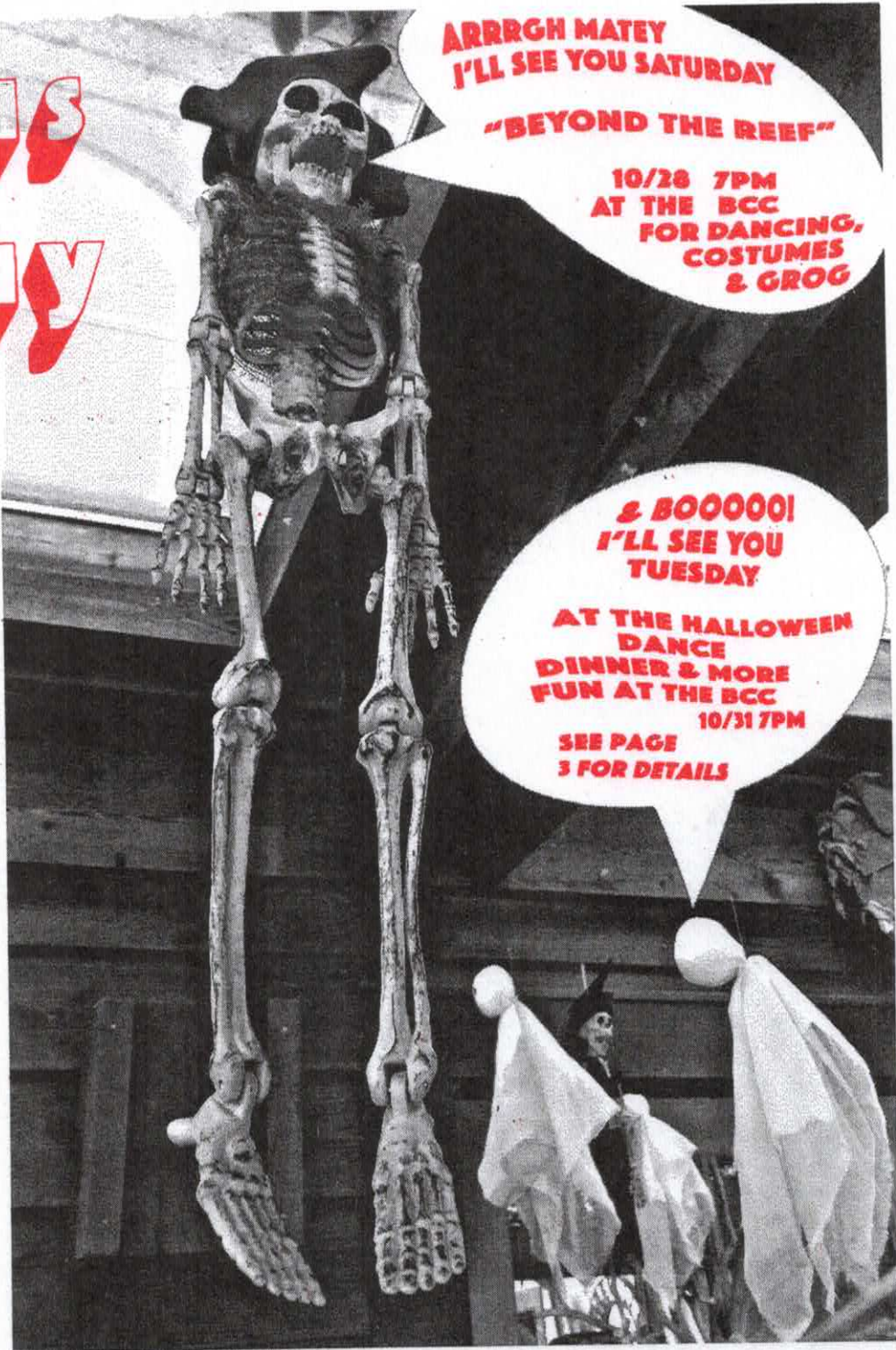

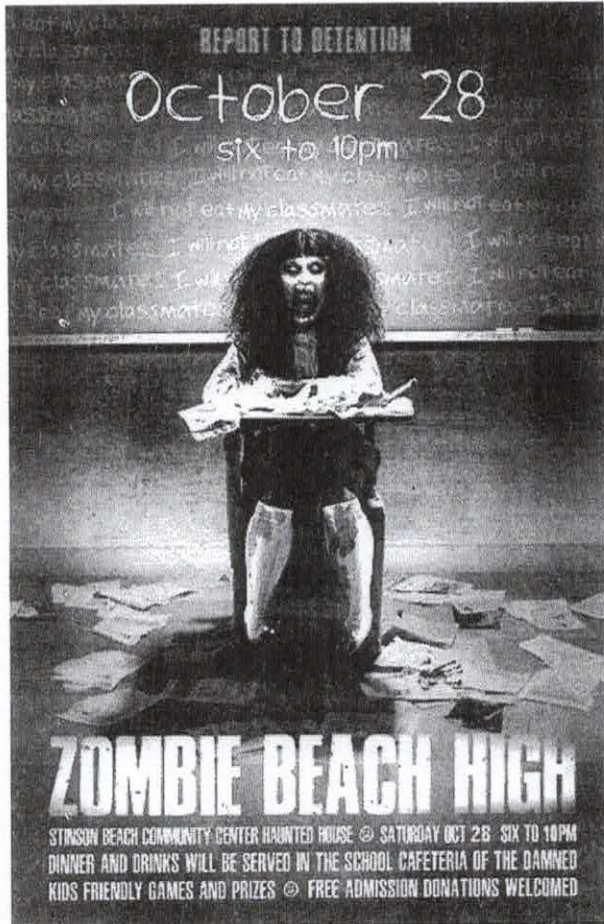

General obligation bonds are often used by school districts in California to pay for large projects that would not be affordable through a school's regular funding sources; bonds typically pay for new construction and major upgrades of existing facilities and are not used for normal operating expenses.

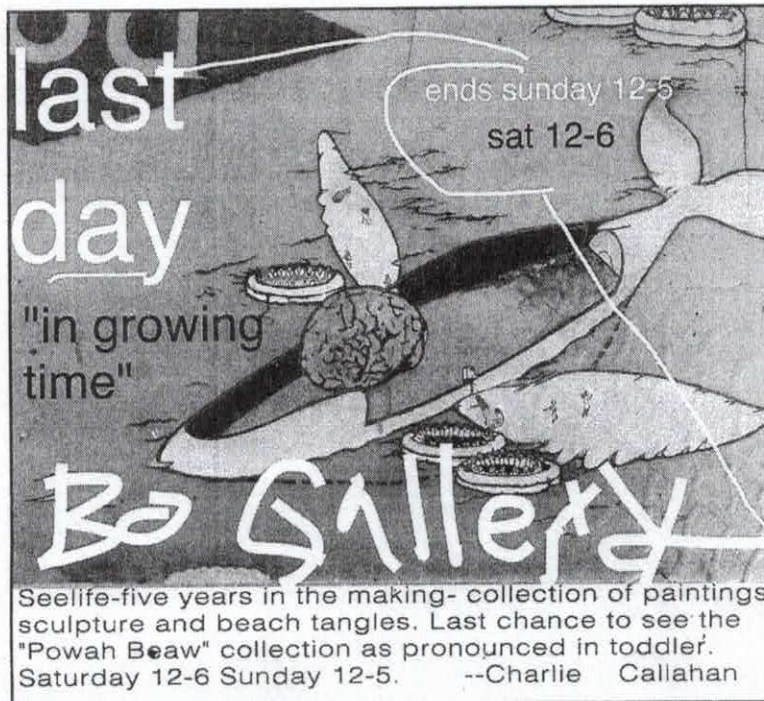
Seeking Sponsors

Helen Diane Cummings passed away peacefully at home on the island of Maui on September 16, 2017 at the age of 70.

Helen was born in Cleveland, Ohio in 1947, the eldest of 4. She was a gypsy and a dreamer with a heart of rock-n-roll and an artist's spirit. After traveling to Israel, with a stint as a production assistant in a Bruce Lee movie in Barcelona, she moved to Bolinas in 1969 where she met and then married Mickey Cummings (...at the Gibson House).

Helen & Mickey deeply planted their hearts in the Bolinas community. They raised two children and lived the hippie dream. Aside from their master gardening, Helen and Mickey were involved in the inception of so many of Bolinas' early artistic cooperatives: The Mesa Press, Radio Free Bolinas, The Harvest of Dance. Helen was a Happy Hooper and "manager" of the legendary Bolinas band Living Proof. In the early 80's she launched her own production company "Cummings Attractions Productions". Everything about Helen always had an element of theater.

Helen and Mickey moved to Maui in 1985 and divorced, but remained family. Helen started her massage therapy studio, Back to Center Massage, and worked as a rehabilitation therapist for over 25 years. During that time she developed a line of natural health and beauty products called Maui Excellent.

She is famous for her aromatherapy Hawaiian fragrance blends and her signature Volcano Oil designed for massage. Helen was passionate about her business. She loved her family and her animals and rhythm & blues. She had a smile that lit up a room and an amazing spirit and energy that will not be forgotten. She loved Maui, but always felt like Bolinas was her home.

Helen leaves behind her daughter, Julia Cummings, and son, Jamison Cummings, and her two granddaughters Addison and Piper as well as her cherished friends and business partners Steven Bearman and Artie Blaquiére.

As were Helen's wishes, her children will be spreading her ashes into the Pacific Ocean from the beach at Wharf Road on Saturday Oct 28th between 12-12:30. All are welcome to celebrate her memory & bid Helen farewell.

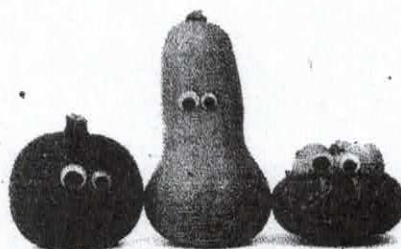

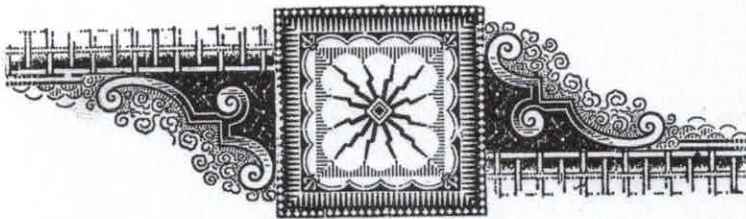

I wonder how many people reading this attended the Gabriel Faure's Requiem performance in 2008 at the Bolinas Community Center?

That was the first performance in my memory, although I know that some local singers had performed this masterwork before I moved to town in 2004. A little history...In 2007, I started a local performing arts organization in order to put on a youth production of *Narnia* with our beloved Sarah MacDonald. In a last minute act of desperation, less than a week before we opened, I rounded up some local adult choral singers to support/save the musical -- trust me, it needed it! Michael Rafferty was one of those singers, and a few months later, he suggested we keep the ball rolling with an adult chorus. Apparently, it had been some time since a choral director lived in town, and many wanted to continue singing. So Michael handed me a copy of the score and told me he'd help round up singers, if I was willing to conduct. Even though I was young and lacking in experience, *or maybe because of it*, I gave an enthusiastic yes. The production grew in size, and Lisa Townsend and Joanna Haigood joined the crew adding their choreography, which included both professionals and community dancers. I wrote a new orchestral arrangement for piano and a bass clarinet quartet called Edmund Welles, and Heidi Gross created a beautiful atmosphere with her paintings and stage design.



Since 2007, we have done dozens of various community productions, but Faure's *Requiem* is the only one that has repeated. It has taken a lot of forms, and over the last several if not many years, we have performed at the Bolinas Cemetery, both outdoors, and inside the lovely Mary Magdalene Church. We love this composition, and have marinated over the years in its rich harmonies and transcending melodies. This year will be our last year singing this piece (Mozart might be calling...), and we very much hope that you can join us for our performance on **Saturday, November 4th**. We will be inside this year, to take advantage of the acoustics, especially since we will have Katy Boyd joining us on cello. Starting at 6 p.m. however (and weather permitting) we will have acoustic cello outside in the cemetery with the chance to walk around and listen to live music. There will have a table set up if you'd like to add a picture of an ancestor who has passed, and we'll have some refreshments as well. Think of it as our take on the day of the dead holiday. At 7 p.m. we will begin the choral portion of

the evening inside the church, with soloists Chris Ruppe & Matt Lewis. We are asking for a \$10-20 donation, to support our scholarship fund, but no one will be turned away. Please come, we'd certainly love to see you: 16 Horseshoe Hill Road

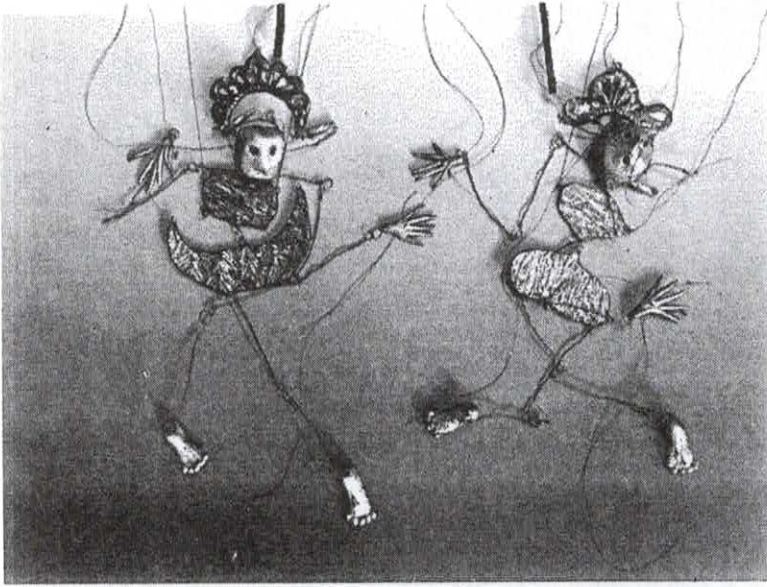

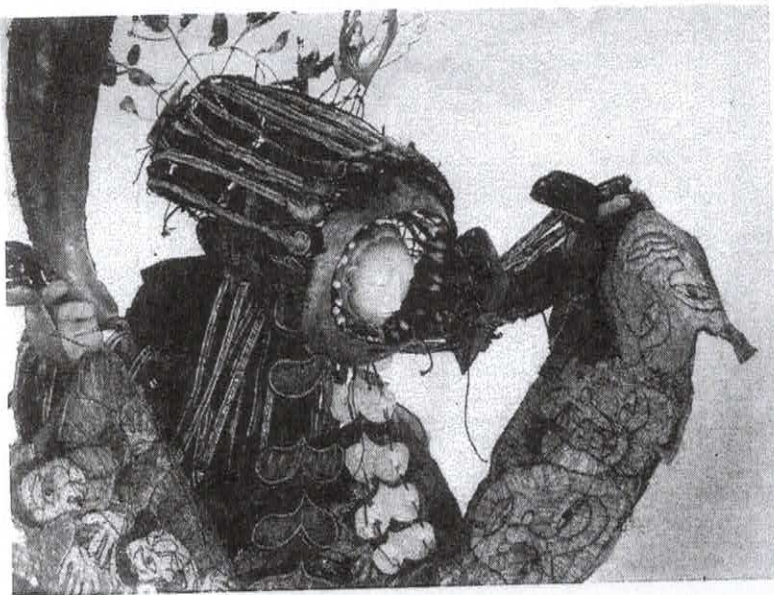


International performance/sculptural artist, **Sha Sha Higby** creates exquisite and ephemeral body sculpture that she performs in in solo-performances.
