



Common Voice Choir Series - Winter



I asked Diane if The People's Store would be willing to carry it.



Dear West Marin Residents,

If you have been thinking about decommissioning or replacing your woodburning fireplace or wood stove with a gasburning device or electric heat pump, now is your last chance to apply for financial assistance from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District. The district's Wood Stove Rebate Program is almost out of funding for priority projects in high wood smoke areas such as yours.

Residents in West Marin and the San Geronimo Valley residents can receive at least \$2,500 for a removal and replacement project, or \$2,250 for decommissioning. The rebate amount can increase up to \$12,000 based on your project and income level. Rebate levels cannot exceed 100% of the total project cost.

The Marin County Community Development Agency's Sustainability Team has been working closely with the district to encourage residents to take advantage of this generous rebate opportunity since the current grant cycle started in August 2016. The district recently informed us that the fund is running out, and can't guarantee when a new grant cycle will take place.

To apply, visit www.baaqmd.gov/grant-funding/residents/wood-smoke-rebate and click on Apply Now. You will be informed that the program has exhausted its funds and you have been placed on a waitlist. Residents in high wood smoke areas will be given priority on the waitlist. You should be contacted by the district in no more than two weeks with a notice to proceed with your project. Please be aware of what projects and types of gas-burning appliances are eligible for the program. You can submit questions directly to the district by emailing grants@baaqmd.gov

Marin residents also are encouraged to apply to Marin County's wood smoke abatement rebate program for additional funding. Visit www.maringreenbuilding.org and click on the Wood Stove Rebate Program tab to download the application. We encourage residents to apply to the Air District's program first because funds for that program are low and they require approval before you start your project.

Rebates for energy-saving projects like new windows, insulation, building air sealing, HVAC replacement, and more are available through a separate program called Energy Upgrade California ® Home Upgrade. Visit www.marincounty.org/energyupgrade or give our County of Marin office a call for more information.






