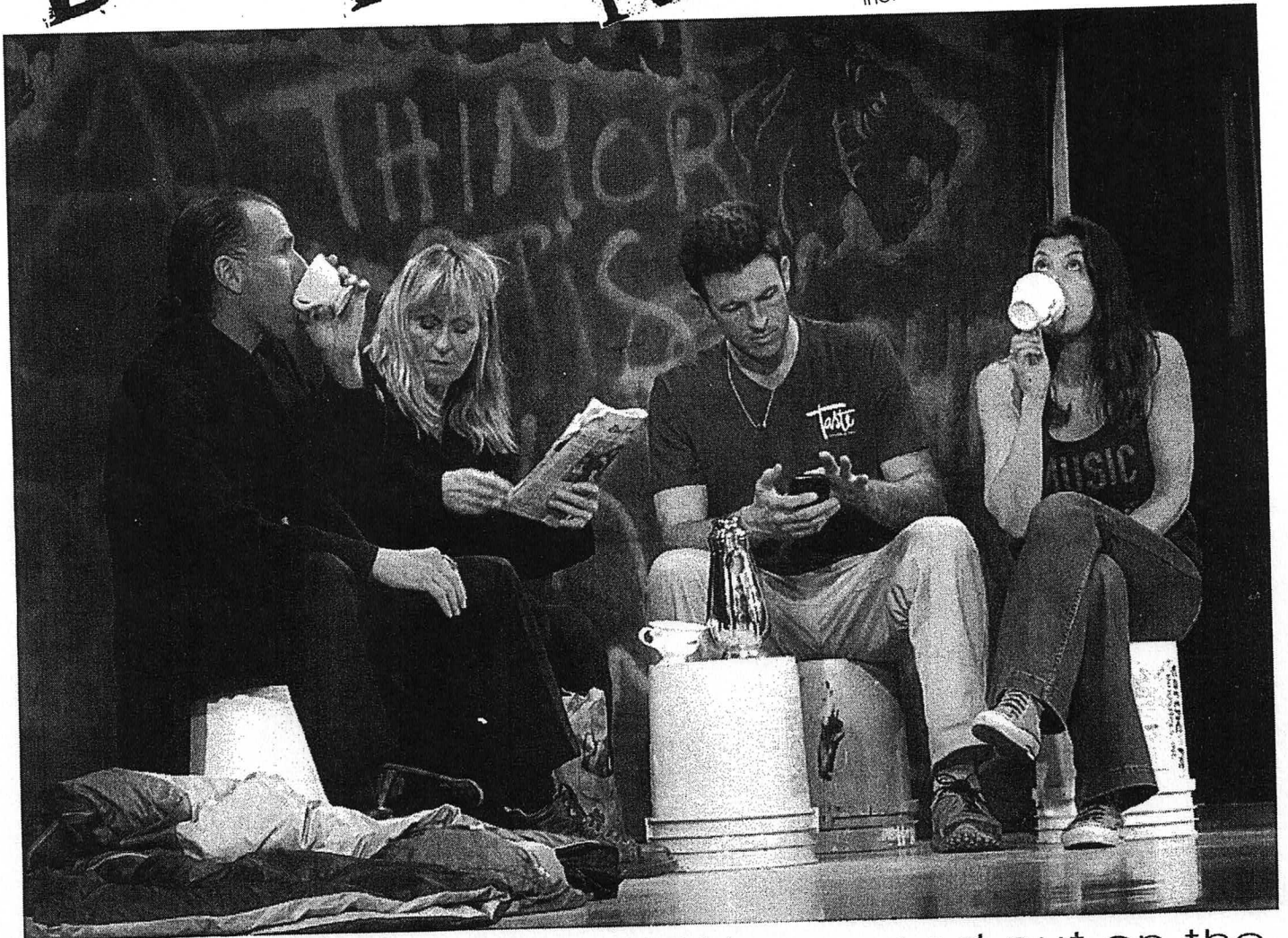

As a result of the enactment of the California Voter Participation Rights Act, the BCPUD Board of Directors will consider BCPUD Resolution 650, which will change the date of the BCPUD Board elections from November odd-numbered year elections to November even-numbered year elections. If this resolution is enacted by the BCPUD Board, and then approved by the Marin County Board of Supervisors, the next district Board election will be held on November 6, 2018 and the terms of each of the current Board members will be extended by one year.

4. BCPUD Comment Letter to the California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC") Staff's Draft White Paper: High Impact Areas for Broadband Availability.

The CPUC is seeking public comment on its draft White Paper which, among other things, identifies Bolinas as one of thirteen "high impact areas" to prioritize for deployment of broadband internet infrastructure: "In particular, we seek comments on the methodology used [to select the high impact areas], whether existing Internet service providers already serve the identified areas, if current providers will commit to serve the identified areas, or if we inadvertently overlooked a particular community."

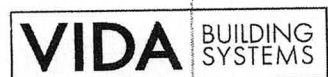

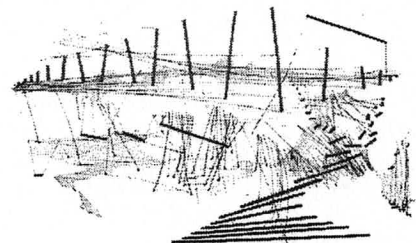

A BIASED REVIEW
OF A SHOW NOT TO BE MISSED

Of course I'm biased!
 When I say you shouldn't miss Judy Molyneux's wonderful show at the Bolinas Gallery--in its final weekend this Saturday and Sunday--of course I'm biased.

But my biases are a very good reason for you to take my recommendation.

Because I--like most Bolinas old-timers--was totally enamored of Judy's old-style paintings in the 70's and 80's. Those lovely landscapes that so superbly depicted the coming and going of light and fog, the lagoon, the mountains --and those great venue paintings, showing Bolinas people going about their lives. (She was a masterful portrait painter--check out the old-style work in her big retrospective book when you visit the gallery.)

So it was by no means a sure thing that I would continue to be an admirer as she gradually transmuted into painting that left representational realism behind, moving more and more into an adventurous free play of color and form.

I could easily have become an ex-fan, as Judy moved on, I do, after all, have something of a bias toward representational painting. (Though I thought Joey Koppal's show in the Gallery last month was incredible!)

But when you see this show, you'll know what I mean when I say that in Judy's current work her love of paint and painting is so very musical!

The subjects are still there--the surfers, the dogs, the cliffs, the ocean, the light. (The show is called "At the Water's Edge".) But it is all a musical fantasy that warms your heart and makes you laugh with pleasure as you take in her bright play of color and her always inventive sculpting of form.

Don't miss it. Last weekend. Bolinas Gallery. Saturday and Sunday, 1-5 p.m.
