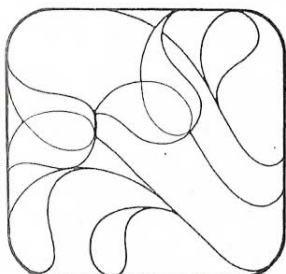
Well lately since I got Dragon speak I've been emailing people I never would've emailed before. 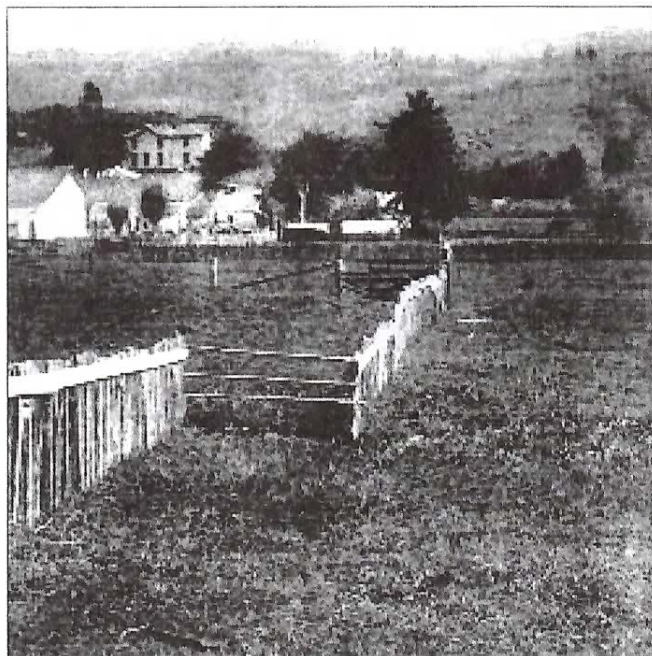
