Deadline for application submissions is April 30, 2018

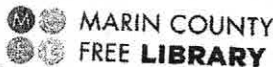

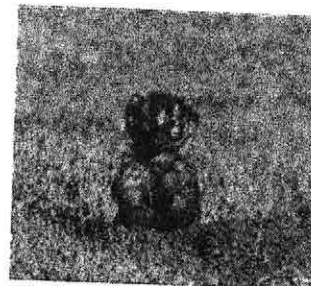


FIRE CADET PROGRAM

The Bolinas Fire Protection District is accepting applications for the new Fire Cadet Program. The purpose of the Fire Cadet Program is to provide young men and women an inside look of the fire and emergency medicine profession, to help them make the decision of whether they want to pursue a career in this field. This program will help cadets gain experience as they observe and train with firefighters and assist the Department. Each cadet will learn mental and physical wellness, a sense of self-responsibility, personal growth, leadership, teamwork, and fire prevention skills. Anyone between the ages of 16 and 18 years old who lives in the Fire District and can meet the minimum qualifications may apply to participate in the Fire Cadet Program. The Volunteer Firefighters train on Thursday nights from 7 to 9 pm. and on some Saturdays. The Cadets are expected to attend and train on these days with the regular Volunteers unless it interferes with schooling. An additional schedule of training can be set up for the Cadets so both schooling and department training priorities can be met. Tulip Fever (2017)

Set in 17th century Amsterdam during the Tulip Wars, this film centers on the affair between a married noblewoman and a young artist during a very troubling time. She relies on the help of her loyal housekeeper Maria (Holliday Grainger). Derbyshire, England native Jack O'Connell plays the fishmonger Willem Brok. He gained great acclaim in Angelina Jolie's *Unbroken*, (2014), also based on true events.

Apart from the very strong cast, it's an educational film, entertaining, and available on Netflix. While it did not get great reviews, I enjoyed it, and it made me want to read the novel it was based upon.

Community Statement

Over the past month or so there has been swirling talk around the BCLT's new projects and some feelings of uncertainty about our transparency and goals. I would like to take this opportunity to hopefully put some of this to rest and to also explain who we are, what we do and where we are with future plans.

The Bolinas Community Land Trust is your local nonprofit that supports and supplies affordable housing and community sustainability here in Bolinas. Currently we have two properties in the downtown area where we house a total of 22 people; a combination of families, single people, young people and seniors. All of our current tenants work in Bolinas in a variety of professions. We also supply three commercial spaces rented affordably to facilitate positive downtown commerce and community. In addition, the BCLT owns and operates BoGAS, a necessary asset to our community and visitors alike and is essential for our first responders for fire safety throughout West Marin. Our organization is made up of 12 volunteer board members. Our dedicated board give direction to our staff members; Arianne Dar our Executive Director guides the work of myself, Managing Director and Al B Foreman our Gas Station Manager. While their reasons for being on the Board of the BCLT may vary, it is these reasons, and the diverse backgrounds, of the board that helps to express the shared love and responsibility to our community.

The need for housing in Bolinas is a fact that we all understand. We have all heard the school stats which are indeed troubling, but this issue is affecting many kinds of people in our community: Families, single people, elderly, our youth, our business owners and their staff, our service men and women and our emergency responders, teachers, medical staff, the list goes on. We are changing from a community of people who live, work, grow and thrive together to a town of commuters, vacation homes and people struggling to keep up. The housing needs in Bolinas affects everyone and we need to take action.

The BCLT's tireless commitment to the Bolinas Community is that we are YOUR Community Land Trust, we are here for YOU. This commitment extends from the people who desperately need our services to the neighborhoods in which we are a part. We are here today and will continue to be here to have discussions and find solutions to help create and sustain positive relationships with everyone.

We currently have two new properties on the Mesa. 430 Aspen, which is already developed but will need work, and the Overlook lots. We are also in contract for an additional lot on Aspen, contingent on receiving funding.

As we get clearer direction for each of these projects, there will be more discussion and community input, at this point we are still very much at the beginning stages and can't delve into specifics until we know the perimeters of possibilities.

That being said, we have heard your concerns and are paying attention. What we can say now is that because of zoning on the Mesa we can only build on lots that are at minimum 100' x200', and the maximum building on a lot of that size is a single home with a second unit. It is possible to turn a master bedroom into a room rental in the primary structure, which becomes its own studio apartment. We will not build any units now or into our future on the Mesa that are more than one story and they would always have off street parking. We are held to

zoning restrictions, county and coastal commission restrictions, and the water moratorium. As we do receive public funds we are held to very strict standards. We have a full-time property manager and our tenants are drawn from our waitlist, which is also subject to high standards and strict guidelines. We are currently putting together an environmental committee made up of board members and community members to make sure the important views this community shares around our wildlife and native plants is always in the process of any new project.

We have been in dialogue with the neighborhood surrounding our proposed projects. We have heard their concerns and we are paying attention. The board will be meeting to discuss how best to interface with our community around new projects going forward. In the near future we will be ready for community presentations and discussions about new projects and our role in the Bolinas Community.

We thank you for your input, concern and your praise. You are helping us to grow and work through many new issues that come with learning to grow and these opportunities for engagement and understanding will help us be the best we can be for our community. Though it can be uncomfortable, we are making progress and we thank you for helping by being a part of the solution.

In the meantime, we are in our office through the Gas station office doors Monday – Thursday 10-2, and we always welcome visitors with questions and comments. You can also reach us through email at info@bolinaslandtrust.org. We are always happy to talk, to explain, to listen and to dream with you.

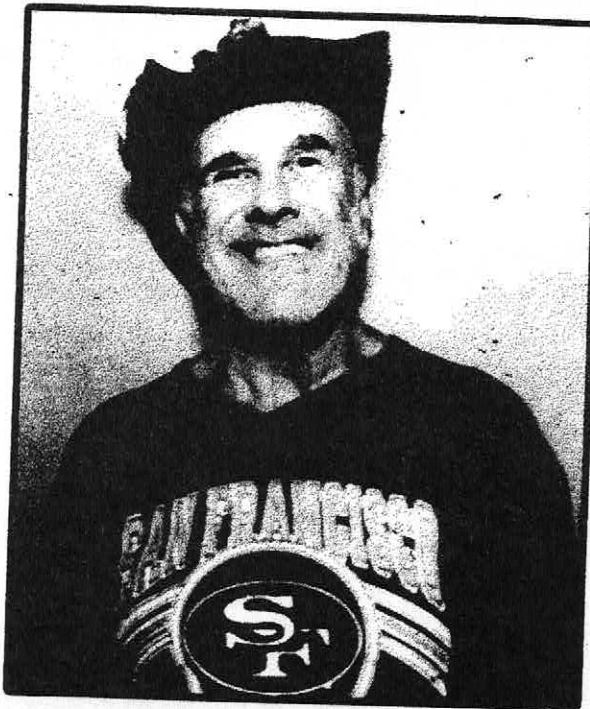

Please join us to celebrate the work of three long time Coastal Marin artists. Two of the exhibitions explore quiet nuances of color and light, while the third bursts with diverse textures and mediums.

FOCUS: PATSY KREBS

Inverness painter Patsy Krebs has been exploring the perception of color and light as an abstract artist for more than 40 years. This FOCUS exhibition features paintings created throughout Krebs's long career that illuminate her continued interest in geometry and subtle gradations of color that invite viewers into a contemplative state of heightened visual awareness.

Her art is represented by Haines Gallery in San Francisco and collected in major museum collections, including the Brooklyn Museum of Art, Denver Museum of Art, San Francisco Museum of Modern Art and Bolinas Museum.

SEAN THACKREY / VENICE: A MEDITATION

Bolinas photographer Sean Thackrey is a connoisseur of life and creativity. Like his taste palette when creating his famous Thackrey wines, his artistic eye savors what is richly nuanced and elusive. In this exhibition of abstract images, he has distilled his familiarity with Venice, Italy into close-up meditations on the subtle richness of the surfaces of the city's walls.

Thackrey, a photographer since age fifteen, was trained in art history, and co-owned, with Bolinas artist Sally Robertson, the Thackrey & Robertson Gallery in San Francisco for 25 years. Today he creates his fine wines in Bolinas with the help of many community members.

HARRIET KOSSMAN: AN EDUCATOR'S ART

A counterpoint to the two meditative exhibitions is the ebullient work of artist Harriet Kossman, a nationally recognized art educator whose life is entwined with her Bolinas Community. It is rare and exciting to see a solo exhibition of her work, from prints from the 1970s to current drawings, multi-media paintings, bead-encrusted cups and small, playful sculptures.

Kossman earned her master's degree at the University of Miami, then found her way to Bolinas. In 1972, with the help of innovative townspeople, she co-founded the award-winning Bolinas-Stinson School Art Shop program, and taught art to nearly every child of two generations who attended the school during her forty years there. She helped develop nationwide standards for K-12 art education. But her first love is involving community members in creative projects such as the iconic mural on the side of Bolinas Market.

Everyone is welcome! Come for the always fascinating talks by the artists and curators at 2 PM. The reception is 3-5 PM. Admission to Bolinas Museum exhibitions is always free.
