Community Expression:

1) Don Smith: Sun Festival10:30am baby blessing on the beach and after head to the park around noon.(Sat. June 20th) Asking for the use of cobb oven (run by Melinda Stone) and setting up of Maypole in the Labyrinth in Downtown Park. Bringing tables and having kids activities. The maypole would be dug into the gravel in center of Labyrinth and ropes tied to a few trees. There is are volunteers who

will make sure of clean up. Charles: contact Arn on the day of to open/close the oven. Angle motions, Victoria seconds (3-0)approved.

  - 4) There was a BMW doing loops in the field behind the skate park at Mesa Park. Charles: We will need to post signs about vehicles in the park being prohibited. The locks were cut or taken which left the gate open. We will replace the locks and have maintenance keep an eye on the gate.

On or about 1853, Joseph Almy of Dogtown, aware that lumber delivered in S.F. was worth \$2 a foot; set off with a raft of 40,000 feet of lumber. Being unfamiliar with the tides, his raft went ashore near the Big Lagoon (Muir Beach). All, however, was not lost, as Mr. Almy went on to become county judge. Other Dogtown residents of the time became county sherriff, county treasurer, San Rafael's pioneer banker, superior judge and Bolinas' first grocers. 


