Board Members Present: Angie Calpestri, Victoria Maier, Charles Whitefield, Mark Lucanic

Others: Ambre Dailey, Ro'von Sanders, Don Smith, Angela Vernon

Appointing Mark Lucanic as Brian Lee's replacement on the board.

## Community Expression:

- 1) Don Smith: Sun Festival- 10:30am baby blessing on the beach and after head to the park around noon. (Sat. June 20<sup>th</sup>) Asking for the use of cobb oven (run by Melinda Stone) and setting up of Maypole in the Labyrinth in Downtown Park. Bringing tables and having kids activities. The maypole would be dug into the gravel in center of Labyrinth and ropes tied to a few trees. There is are volunteers who

will make sure of clean up.

Charles: contact Arn on the day of to open/close the oven.

Angie motions, Victoria seconds (3-0) approved.

- 2) Angela: I think we need a formal write up of procedures to hand to people when they are approved to use the oven. Dylan is working on a website that states policies and procedures as well as who to contact for the oven rental. We still have issues of kids climbing the hillside, could we put up barrier tape? Charles: we could put up some black plastic construction fence with signs. Also, we can't have tables or chairs on or blocking the handicapped space. Chaz: Could ask to secure a \$50 deposit for big events.
- 3) Flagship parking issues. Ambre: we are parking on the drive with the permission of the board, we can't park further back because of the slope so we parked next to the dentist who got very upset that the bus was next to his office, even though his office is closed during this time. We have been parking in front of the library and will try to do so in the future. We would love to be at your future events. Angela: we still need to paint red on the street
- 4) There was a BMW doing loops in the field behind the skate park at Mesa Park. Charles: We will need to post signs about vehicles in the park being prohibited. The locks were cut or taken which left the gate open. We will replace the locks and have maintenance keep an eye on the gate.

## Downtown Park:

- 1) Deadly Nightshade plant by labyrinth is concerning parents. Charles: we need to remove it. Victoria motions Angie seconds (4-0) approved
- 2) Power washing bathrooms- Chaz will bring the washer to Downtown park.
- 3) Fixing broken pipe under the memorial bench? Angela: the leak has been fixed.
- 4) Weed whipping of hillside. We lost a lot of oak trees due to the drought. Angela: we need to do it twice next year so that the thistles seed which makes it harder. It would be best to do it in April or earlier and again in June, depending on the rain. There was a lot of garbage on the top from someone camping. Cleared lower growth so there is more visibility.

On or about 1853, Joseph Almy of Dogtown, aware that lumber delivered in S.F. was worth \$2 a foot, set off with a raft of 40,000 feet of lumber. Being unfamiliar with the tides, his raft went ashore near the Big Lagoon (Muir Beach). All, however, was not lost, as Mr. Almy went on to become county judge. Other Dogtown residents of the time became county sherriff, county treasurer, San Rafael's pioneer banker, superior judge and Bolinas' first grocers. 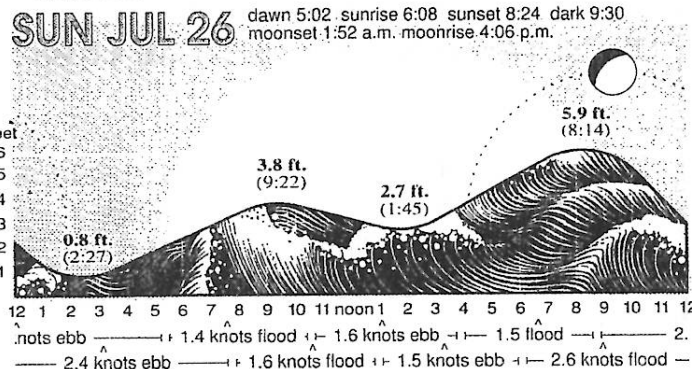
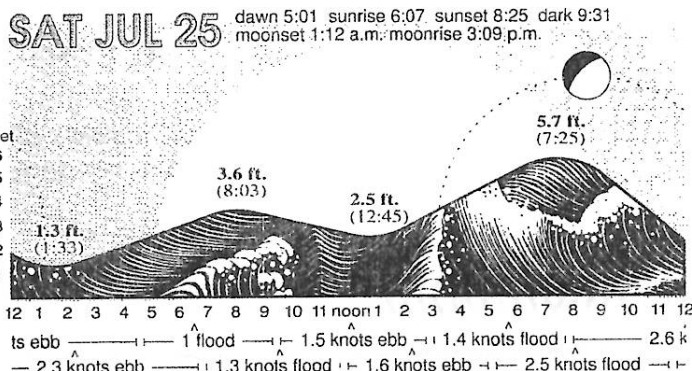
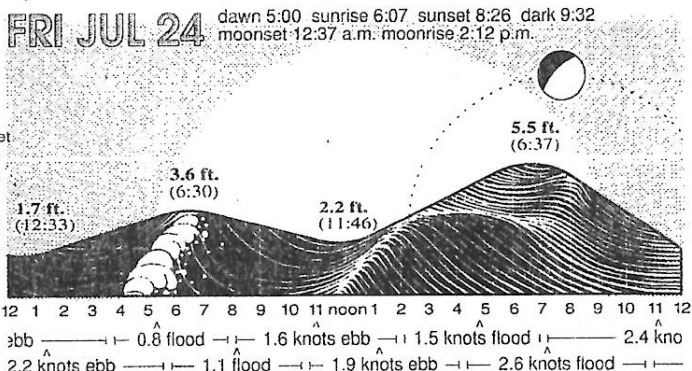
