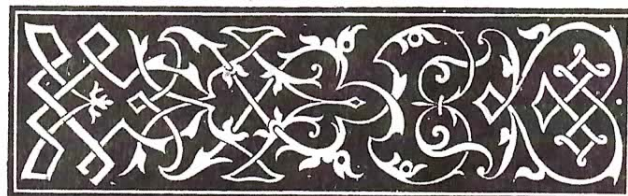
This wide range of experiences is possible because of the support we receive both from talented locals who are willing to share their skills with children and from the community as a whole, for which we are truly grateful.
