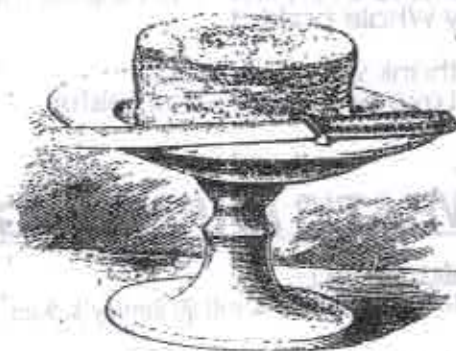

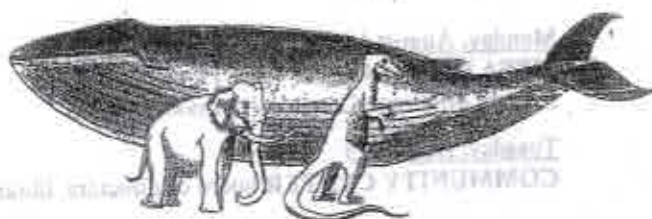

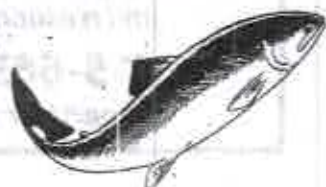

## Script

This Happening is called **The Panoramic Sea Happening**. It will soon happen on Brighton Beach in the village of Bolinas six miles from Sausalito Beach and twenty four miles from San Francisco. The included sector of the beach is about 550 yards long the presence of the sea should impose itself by motion, rhythm and sound texture within human perceptual capacity.

### THE RAFT OF MEDUSA

June 18, 1810

The frigate Medusa attended by three other ships, a corvette Eclat, a freighter Larus and a brig Argus, left France for Saint Louis, Senegal, with the governor and higher officials of the Colony on her board. She was bearing about four hundred men, crew and passengers. On the 2nd of July she encountered the Argus' bank, and after five days of vain efforts to launch her to the open, a raft was built and it took one hundred and forty nine men, while the rest rushed to life boats. Soon after the boats cut away the ropes that were pulling the raft, thus leaving it on the churning waters of the ocean. Hunger, thirst, sleeplessness, and the presence of the sea should impose itself by motion, rhythm and sound texture within human perceptual capacity. Finally, after twelve days of inhuman suffering, Argus took aboard fifteen dying men.

All this process is a sort of an investigation for evidence.

The Year 1818

With love for remembrance as characteristic for our epoch he made a report of the Medusa wreckage: he worked as sternly, persistently and minutely as a public prosecutor. He gathered a vast dossier packed with all sorts of genuine documents and materials. He entered in close relations with Médecins Carraud and Sauvigny, the main actors of the drama left among the living.

He found Médusa's carpenter, one of the fifteen rescued from death, and got him to make a model of the raft being a pedantically exact copy, with all details of carpentry reproduced, and on the raft he put wax figures.

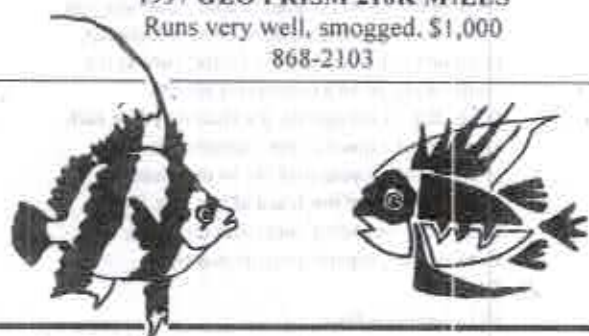

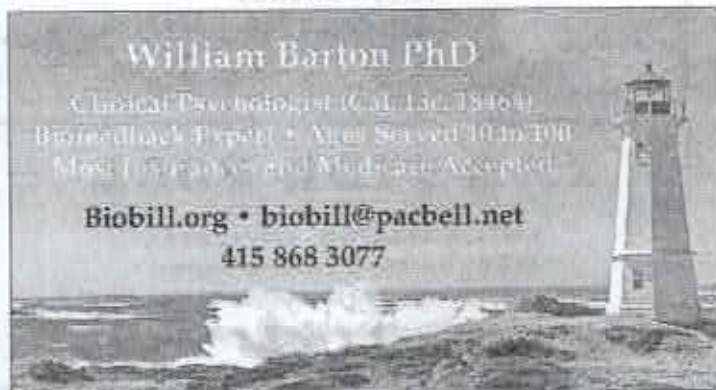
