COMMUNITY MEETING with University of San Francisco regarding Star Route Farm

As we now know Star Route Farm [SRF] has been bought by the University of San Francisco [USF], and a lot of people in town are wondering what is going to happen now. To that end there is going to be a community meeting on Sun. Sept. 10 at 4 PM. in the Community Center. We have invited Don Heller, the Provost of USF, to join us in a conversation with community members. We see this as an opportunity for us to get to know each other. We are all curious to hear what plans USF has for the farm and also have questions regarding its use going forward.

Star Route has such a major presence here. It surrounds our school and is the entrance to our town. It speaks to who we are, our ethics and our love for the land. Like all of us I wanted to see the farm go into hands that would continue the legacy of SRF, someone who would treat the land and workers with respect and would enrich the organic agriculture community of not only Bolinas but of all West Marin.

I believe USF is up to the task. The farm will continue to be just as it has always been, the oldest certified organic farm in California. It is still known as Star Route Farm. They are already working on better housing for the workers. I trust their commitment to social justice and their deep spiritual connection to Gods creation. I truly believe they want to work with and be a part of the community. So for myself I welcome USF.

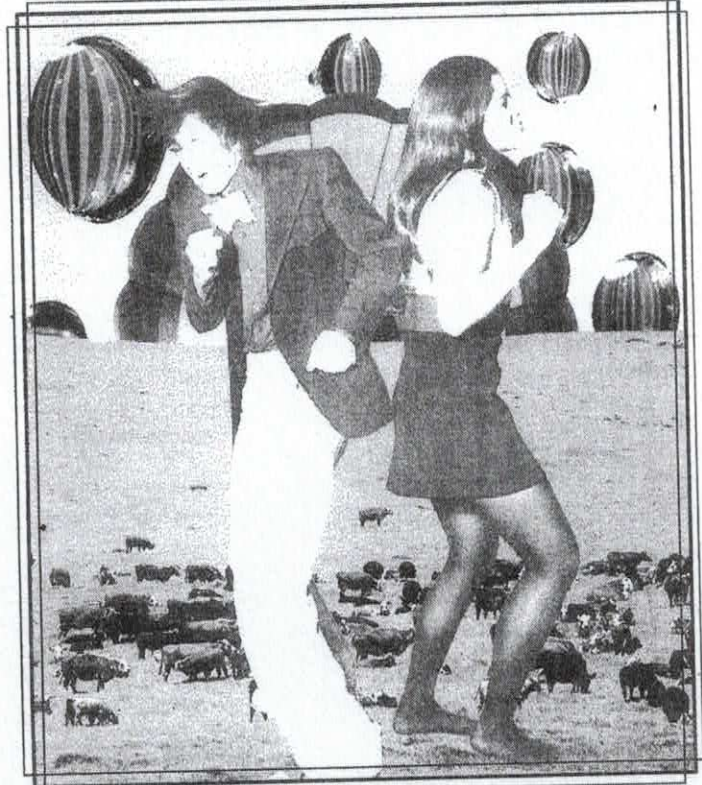

Our quilt will be raffled off at an event this winter, expect to see it finished and around town this fall and winter while we start to sell tickets! For more information on how to participate please contact us!

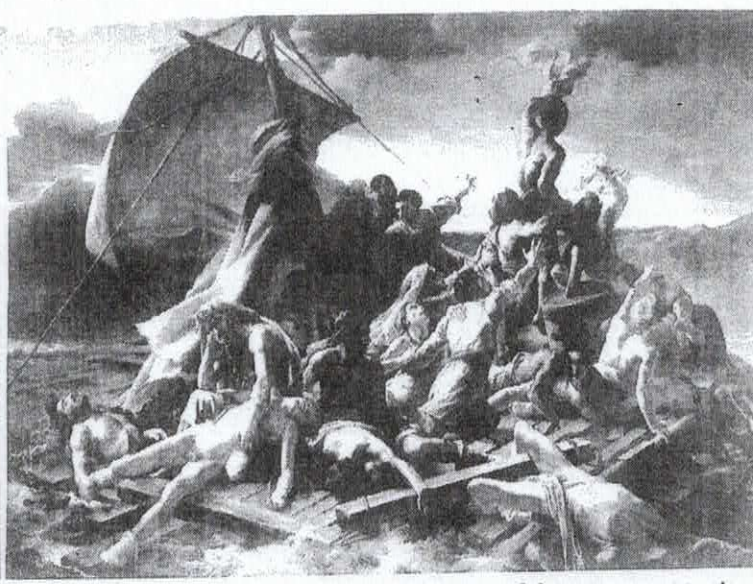
