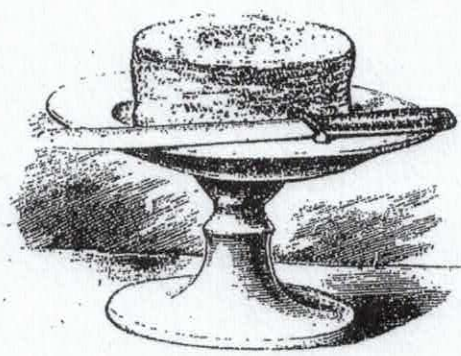

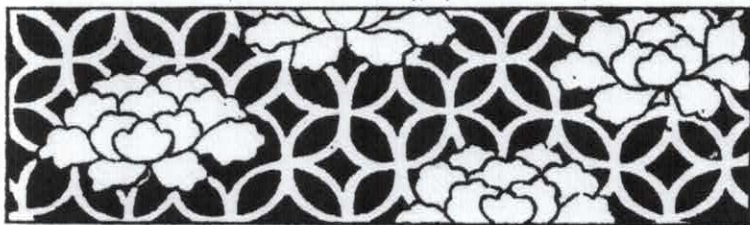

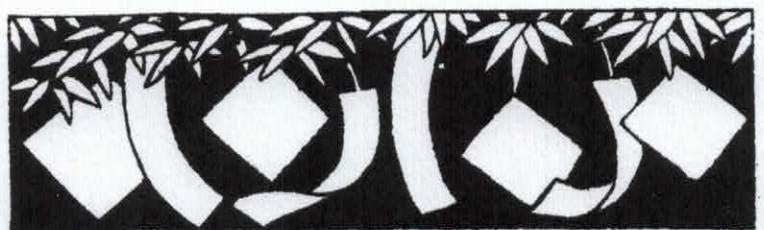

Huffman and Rodoni to headline health care town hall

Congressman Jared Huffman and Supervisor Dennis Rodoni will be featured guests at a Point Reyes Station community meeting on the subject of health care sponsored by West Marin Standing Together on Friday, September 15, at the West Marin School. The event is an opportunity to discuss in depth the issues behind national and state health care reform.

Single payer advocate Ellen Karel, Vice President of Health Care for All-California, and Inverness resident Judy Spelman, RN, Medicare for All supporter who crafted single payer bills which were passed by the California Legislature will also be on the panel. Liza Goldblatt of Point Reyes Station, proponent in integrative medicine and health will serve as moderator.

Several important themes will be addressed in the town hall meeting, according to organizers from West Marin Standing Together. The first is preserving and upgrading the Affordable Care Act. The second is examining the pros and cons of state-based health reform vs. national health reform. The third is determining which options are preferred and devising a political strategy to achieve them. All three will be discussed at the Health Care Town Hall.

The local organizers who have been delving into this issue since the election believe that there is a rare opportunity for Americans who favor single payer or a Medicare For All reform, now roughly 62% of the population, to stand up together, demand it and expect to influence the political process.

"With Congress in summer recess and Republican political disarray showing few signs of amelioration, it is the outpouring of public resistance and engagement that is driving the news. For this reason, WMST Health Committee believes this is the moment for the community to inform itself about health reform and consider political action." [Judy Spelman, Inverness]

The community is invited to engage this vital issue with a unique opportunity to hear input from Rep. Huffman and Supervisor Rodoni. The meeting will take place at the gymnasium the West Marin School, from 7:00-9:00 pm. The event is free, but seating is very limited, so WMST encourages the public to register with "Eventbrite Tickets-Health Care Town Hall (put in Jared Huffman/Point Reyes Station). Bring your registration with you to the event. Donations to the ongoing activism of West Marin Standing Together (WMST) are welcome.
