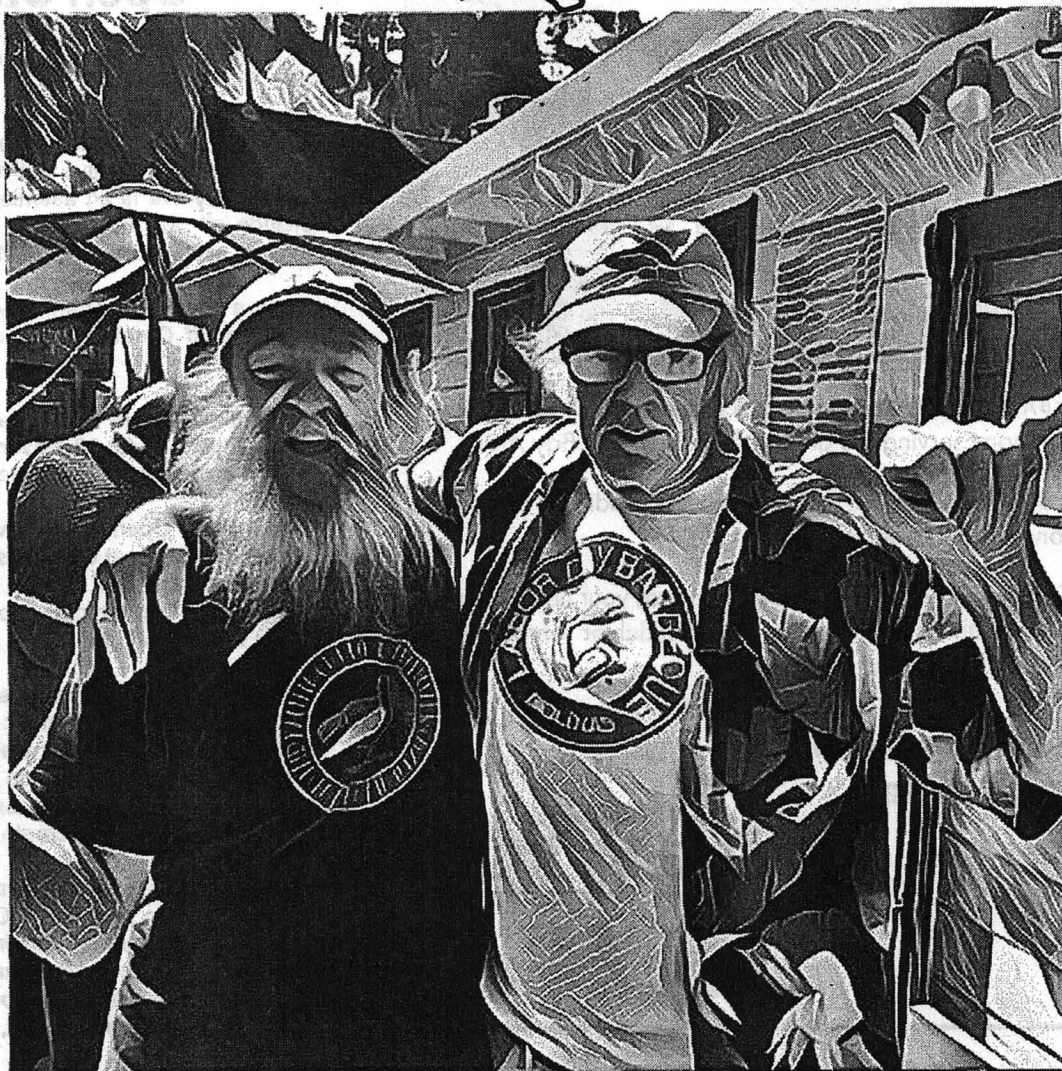

Creativity and Art are such a dominant spirit here in Bolinas, it almost shouldn't come as a surprise that I've been able to count some ninety-five active artists and artisans among us. Still, ninety-five is an astonishing number, and it doesn't even include all our neighbors in film, music, dance, architecture, design, writing and poetry. What a wonderful town we live in.

Once a year – on Thanksgiving Weekend - we celebrate this Bonanza of Creativity with our Bolinas/Stinson Beach Open Studio.

We, the artists, are now in the process of planning for our next Open Studio on 26-28 November, 2016. Every local artist and artisan is invited to participate.

While many Open Studio events have also become a great opportunity to meet collectors and to sell work, their origin and core meaning have always been to share with neighbors a glimpse into the original - typically invisible and intimate - part of the world of art: the artist's place and process of creation.

Participating in Open Studios actively enriches the cultural life of our Community. Whether you're an established artist with galleries far away, locally well-known, or an artist working just for your own satisfaction – to allow a glimpse into your creative space lets the community experience a bit of how you work and why and what you create.

The event has been a tremendous success for artists and studio visitors in past years. Collectively we welcome hundreds of art lovers, neighbors and interested visitors alike each year. Expenses and work are shared between us participants, and there's no overhead. Expenses for outreach, such as postcards and advertisement, are simply divided evenly.

Because of the needs of printing our brochure/mailler, the deadline for joining the group of participating artists is upon us now. Artists could still join later but could not be listed in the brochure.

Bolinas/Stinson Beach Open Studios will be more successful and fun for everyone, the more of us participate. You're invited to add your energy to the event this year and share a bit of your creative world with your community on at least this one weekend a year.

The hearing will also provide an opportunity for the Planning Commission to issue recommendations to the Board of Supervisors before the Board takes final action on the County's proposed LCP amendments.

The public hearings will be held in the Planning Commission Chambers (Room #328 - Administration Building), Marin County Civic Center, San Rafael, California on **Monday, September 26, 2016 at 10:00 a.m.**

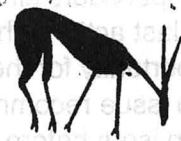

California Coastal Cleanup Day is this Saturday, September 17th from 9-12am. There will be two County sponsored clean-up efforts in Bolinas. One at Kent Island, and the other at Agate Beach.

The County will be hosting the cleanup effort at Agate Beach, and will be on-site beginning at 9am.
