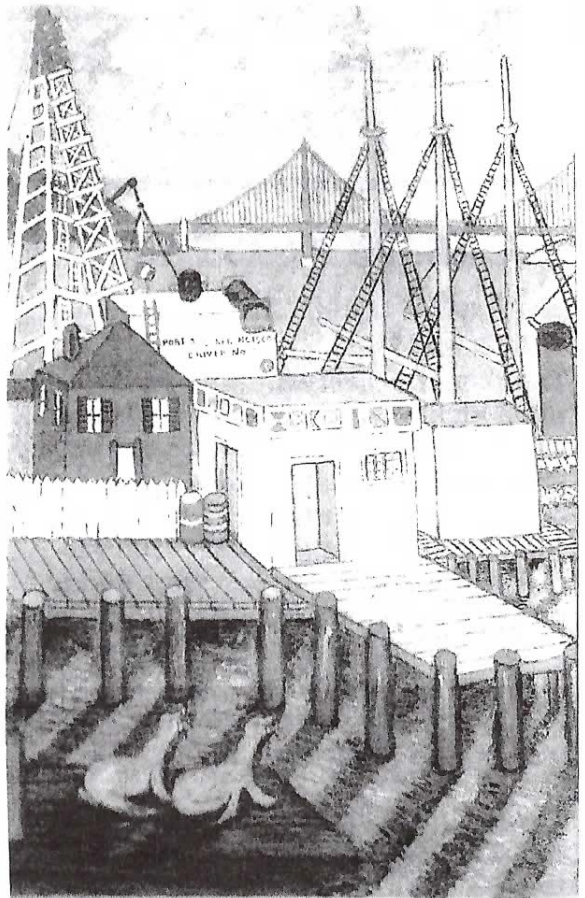
So, you've been here as a resident for 13 years, and you do a lot of public things, I guess.
