Matteo takes us on his eight year long process of making this film. He made the film against all odds and was still living in his van when he started it. Besides showing his process, the film which is mostly shot in Naples and the surrounding area, brings to life the art of pizza making and the spirit of the people who live there.

I first saw this film in the fall at the Mill Valley Film Festival. It played to a sold out crowd. In the question and answer that followed someone asked, "What advice would you have for young artists?" His answer was something like, "Don't listen to anyone who says you can't do it." This answer and the spirit of the film really resonated with me and I wanted to share it. Matteo has graciously agreed to show it for the library. Film Screening and Discussion  
at the Dance Palace

7:00 PM**

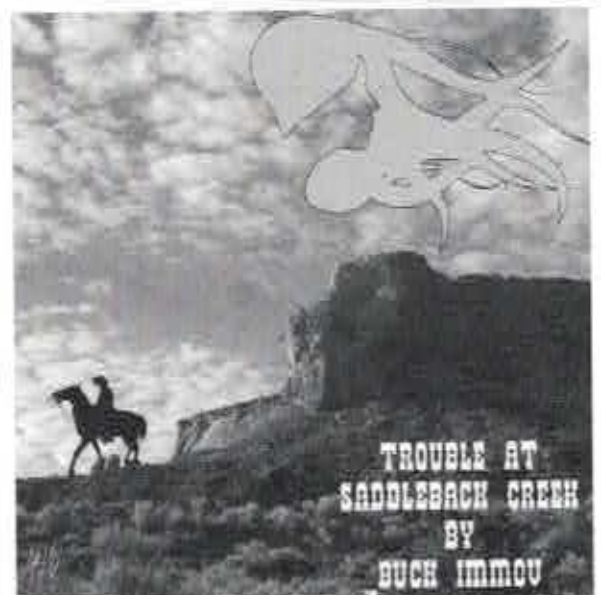
Point Reyes Station---On Saturday March 3rd, the Dance Palace will be presenting a very important film and panel discussion: Evolution of Organic. This film created by Academy Award nominated filmmaker Mark Kitchell and narrated by Frances McDormand, celebrates the vanguard of organic agriculture.

Pioneers and industry mavericks of the organic food movement tell the story of the rise of organic farming and food. A motley crew of back-to-the-landers, spiritual seekers and farmers' sons and daughters rejected modern chemical farming and set out to invent organic alternatives. We learn how organic culture becomes a part of agriculture and how the soil under our feet may save us from global warming. The film screening will be followed by a panel discussion featuring the filmmaker and also local leaders of the organic farming movement including John Wick of Marin Carbon Project and Nicasio Native Grass Ranch, Arron Wilder of Table Top Farm, Jim Baum of Marin Community Farm Stands, Loren Poncia of Stemple Creek Ranch and Caymin Ackerman of Big Mesa Farm.

This event is made possible by the following supporters: Table Top Farm, The Living Seed Company, Point Reyes Flowers, Devil's Gulch Ranch, Marin Community Farm Stands, Marin Roots Farm, Tomales Farmstead Creamery.
