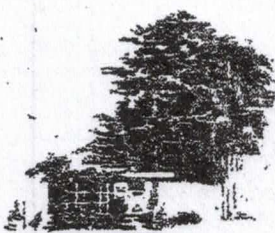

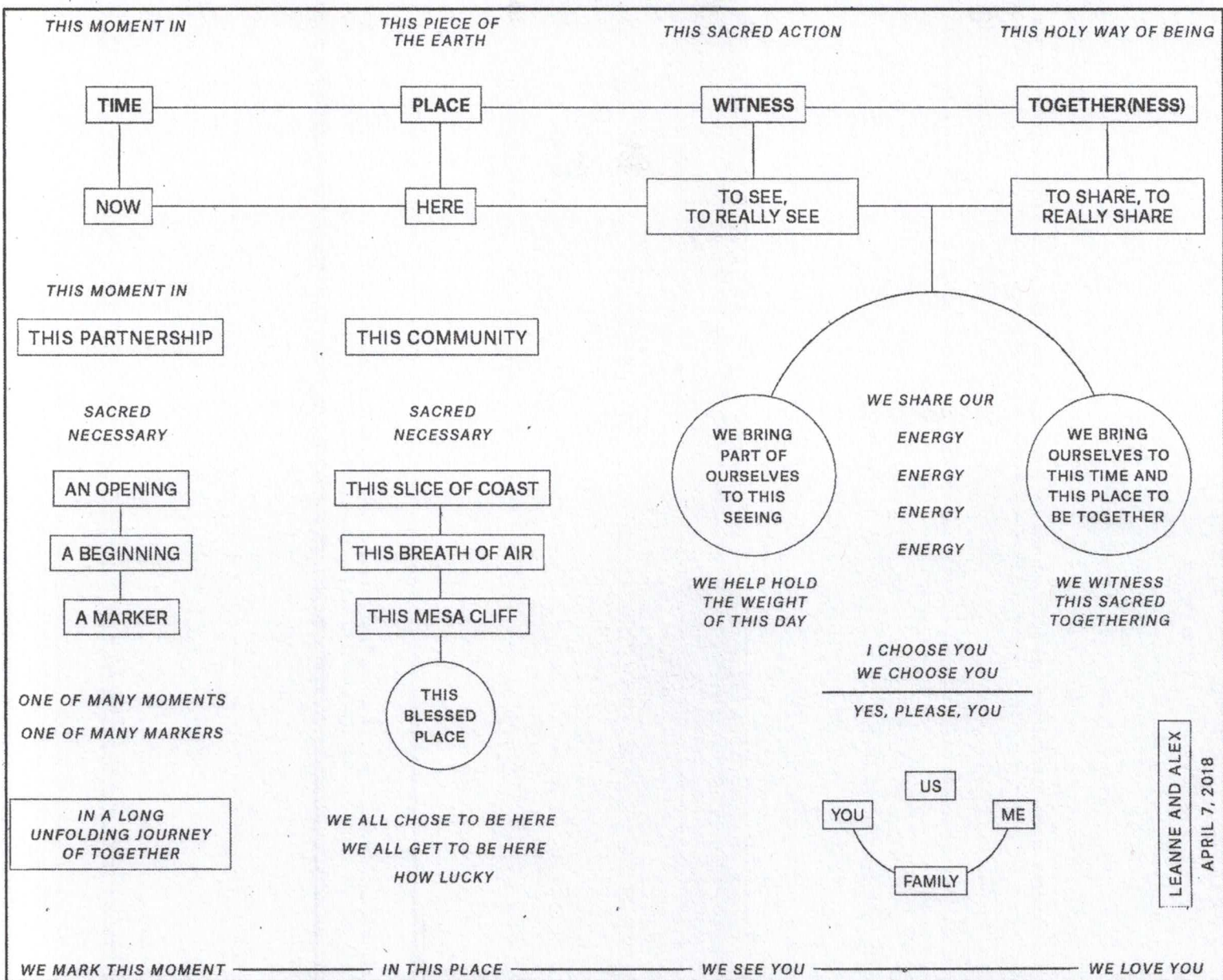

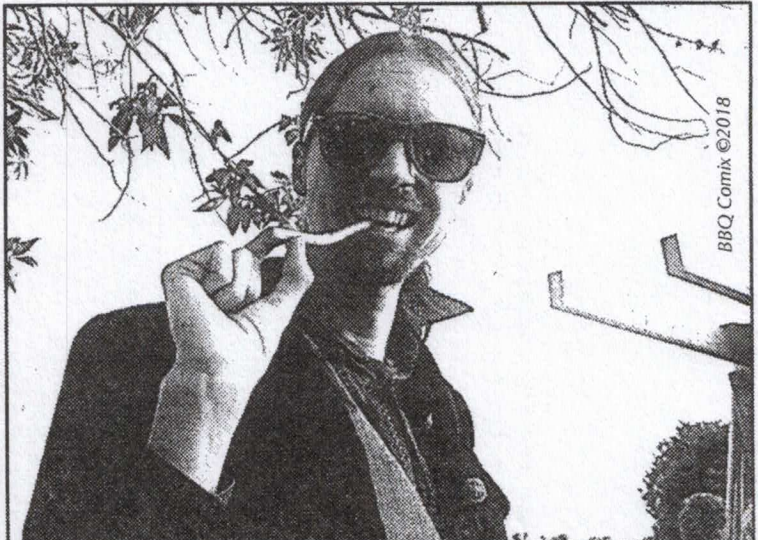

La Bamba a Song Jarocho

A song of civil unrest in 1683 Veracruz, Mexico.

The government was not supporting the population against pirates including : Lorenz de Graaf, who had the people of Veracruz kidnapped for three day in the church. They were thinking if they had a long ladder and another small one, they could escape. The long ladder would help them to go to the rooftop of the church and the small one would help them to climb to the bell tower where they could escape . From this event came one of the verses of the song La Bamba which is: " To climb to heaven you need a long ladder and a small one". There is up and up and up I will go. Bamba, bamba
