

Jesse was an only child, and the bond with his parents remains strong. The family sometimes collaborates on group projects: Their latest, an installation of images inspired by Point Reyes National Seashore, runs through Nov. 13 at the Bolinas Museum.







Cancelling Coastal Route 62 due to low ridership (only two weekdays is what doesn't work!)


Modifying the peak season of South Route 61 to match rider demand.


